**ORDINANCE NO. 01 - 2011**

**ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN  
TIMES ON ALL STREETS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 160, Section 160-19 entitled "Parking prohibited certain hours," of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale, shall be amended by the following amendment to Subsection A. which shall read in its entirety as follows:

- A. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any street in the Borough of Riverdale during the hours between midnight and six o'clock AM during the months of December through March inclusive.

**SECTION 2.** If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**SECTION 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
