ORDINANCE NO. 02 - 2011

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 147 AND PROHIBITING THE PLACEMENT OF MATERIALS ON PUBLIC SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 147, Section 147-30 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale, shall be amended to be entitled "Obstruction of Streets, Sidewalks or Municipal Rights-of-Way. Placement of any materials on Public Sidewalks" and shall read in its entirety as follows:

§ 147-30. Obstruction of Streets, Sidewalks or Municipal Rights-of-Way. Placement of any materials on Public Sidewalks.

A. No person shall place or permit to be placed upon any street, sidewalk or municipal right-of-way any object or thing that shall in any manner obstruct such street, sidewalk or municipal right-of-way or render travel upon such street, sidewalk or municipal right-of-way dangerous or unsafe.

B. No person shall place goods or materials of any kind upon any public sidewalk for pick -up, delivery, storage, display, or any other purpose. This section shall not apply to goods and materials placed for pick-up for regular solid waste or recycling collection by the Borough hauler.

SECTION 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
