ORDINANCE NO. 4-2007

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR USE OF POLICE SERVICES
BY OUTSIDE CONTRACTORS**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Riverdale permits the utilization of police officers for private contractors during their off-duty hours under circumstances approved of by the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish rates charged to outside contractors for the utilization of Borough police officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that the charge for use of police officers by outside contractors shall be the sum of \$90.00 per hour for police officers on regular time and a half and \$115 per hour for holidays and when police officers are entitled to double time. Police officers shall be assigned to the contractor by the Chief of Police for services as approved by the Chief of Police; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that contractors wishing to utilize the services of the Borough of Riverdale Police Department shall be required to enter into an Agreement promulgated by the Borough Clerk which shall include a requirement that if a bill remains unpaid for a period of over 30 days after mailing or presentment, interest of 8% per annum will be charged on accounts up to \$1,500.00 and 10% per annum on delinquent accounts over \$1,500.00. In addition, any delinquency in excess of \$10,000.00 not paid by the end of the fiscal year will be charged a 6% penalty.
