ORDINANCE NO. 14 - 2011

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 128 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE ENTITLED "PRECIOUS METALS, GEMS, AND JEWELRY DEALERS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 128 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Riverdale, entitled "Precious Metal, Gems, and Jewelry Dealers", shall be amended by the following revision to Section 128-6, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

128-6 Disposal within 20 days of purchase prohibited

No dealer shall sell, melt or change the form of or dispose of any articles purchased or received within 20 days of the date of said purchase, and all such items shall be made available for at least 20 days to any authorized police officer requesting such items.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
