**ORDINANCE NO. 19 - 2008**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 69 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERDALE AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR THE FAILURE TO PAY FALSE ALARM FEES**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverdale, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Chapter 69, Section 69-6 entitled "Violations and penalties," shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

**§ 69-6. Violations and penalties.**

Alarm fees shall be paid within ten (10) calendar days after the mailing of notice. The failure to pay the alarm fees within ten (10) calendar days after mailing shall be a violation of this Chapter. An individual violating this Chapter shall be subject to a penalty to be enforced in the Municipal Court of a fine not to exceed \$500 which shall be paid in addition to the fire alarm fee.

**Section 2.** If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
