**NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, impaired drivers on our nation's roads kill someone every 30 minutes, 50 people per day, and almost 18,000 people each year; and

**WHEREAS**, 34% of motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey are alcoholic related; and

**WHEREAS**, an enforcement crackdown is planned to combat impaired driving, and

**WHEREAS**, the summer season and Labor Day holiday are traditionally times of social gatherings which often include alcohol; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the *Over the Limit Under Arrest 2007 Impaired Driving Crackdown*; and

**WHEREAS**, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from August 17 – September 3, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that The Borough of Riverdale declares its support for the *Over the Limit Under Arrest 2007 Crackdown* from August 17 – September 3, 2007 and pledges to increase awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving.
